If you have already registered for a flu vaccine, and you want to add a COVID-19 vaccine, complete the online COVID-19 vaccine consent form and both vaccines will be given at the same appointment.

Select any available time slot as a placeholder. This will ensure that both vaccines are available at the scheduled appointment.

Online registration is required to guarantee an appointment and ensure the vaccine will be available at the clinic. Walk-ins accepted on a limited basis, as resources allow.
